








## WOMEN'S ELITE AMATEUR GOLF SERIES







#### The Best of the Best

The Men's and Women's Elite Amateur Cup competitions are points races by competing in the respective historic Elite Amateur Golf Series championships.

#### Race To the Finish Line

#### **HOW IT WORKS:**

Elite Amateur Cup point system is the cumulative total of World Amateur Golf Ranking® (WAGR) points earned from competing in the aligned EAGS events. The Elite Amateur Cup winner is the player with the most points at the end of the series that culminates with the Western Amateur for the Men's Series and the LNGA Amateur for the Women's Series.

#### **EXEMPTIONS AND AWARDS:**

Top finishers in the series earn exemptions into USGA Championships, PGA TOUR, and other professional events. A player must compete in a minimum number of events (3 for Men's Series, 2 for Women's Series) to be eligible to receive exemptions. Point standings will be updated weekly on Wednesday during the series.

- A format of 36 holes of stroke play with a cut to the low 32 players for match play.




